**ISSUE OF “NOTICE TO IMPORTER / HAULIER”**

We wish to inform you that from 1 Jun 07, the “Notice to Importer / Haulier” will cease to be issued for inter-gateway transshipment containers and the inbound containers for Licensed Warehouse/Bonded Warehouse. The Notice will continue to be issued for containerized imports under ATA Carnet / Temporary Import Scheme and for containers that have been selected for Customs inspection. A copy of the updated “Notice to Importer / Haulier” is attached.

2 Please note that the relevant permit conditions will continue to be imposed and printed on the Customs Transshipment Permits and Customs Inward Permits. We advise you to check the conditions imposed on the permits for strict compliance at the time of clearance. The clearance requirements for inter-gateway transshipment containers and inbound containers for Licensed Warehouse/Bonded Warehouse are appended below:

- Inter-gateway Transshipment Container  
The container must be produced for clearance at the 1<sup>st</sup> Checkpoint, and at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Checkpoint within 24 hours after its release from the 1<sup>st</sup> Checkpoint.
- Inbound Container for Licensed Warehouse/Bonded Warehouse  
The container must be produced at the “Out” Gate for clearance. You are required to e-file to the Revenue Control Branch for supervision of unstuffing of the container at <http://www.customs.gov.sg>.
