## AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATION OF IMPORTS AND EXPORTS REGULATION

Singapore Police Force is the competent authority for the control of security sensitive items under the Regulation of Imports and Exports Regulations (RIER). As part of our continuous review on control of the import, export and transhipment of the security sensitive items, Police have made amendments to the RIER. The <u>Regulation of Imports and Exports (Amendment) Regulations 2015</u> will come into operation with effect from <u>7 September 2015</u>.

2. The details of the amendments are as follows:

3. Toy or replica explosives, grenades, ammunitions or improvised explosive devices (IED) are new additions to Part C of the First Schedule for Controlled Imports, Controlled Exports and Controlled Transhipment. Traders may use Harmonised System Code: <u>95030099</u> and Product Code: <u>ANECON023</u> when making declarations for these products in TradeNet.

- 4. Anyone importing, exporting or carrying out transhipment of items regulated under the Regulation of Imports and Exports (Amendment) Regulations 2015, which Competent Authority is the Singapore Police Force, must seek approval from Police Licensing & Regulatory Department (PLRD). The trader or his appointed freight forwarder shall submit permit applications for import, export and transhipments online via TradeNet® for approval by PLRD.
- 5. Under the Regulation of Imports and Exports (Amendment) Regulations 2015, it is an offence to import, export or carry out transhipment of controlled items without an approval. Any person who is guilty of an offence under these Regulations shall be liable on conviction to maximum fines ranging from \$100,000 to \$200,000 or 3 to 4 times the value of the goods in respect of which the offence was committed, whichever is the greater, or to maximum imprisonment terms ranging 2-3 years or both.
