OUTBREAK ON AVIAN INFLUENZA (AI) IN DENMARK

Denmark reported an outbreak of H5N8 highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) in a poultry flock in Åsgårde, in the municipality of Helsingør on Zealand.

In view of the outbreak, AVA will impose a temporary restriction on the importation of poultry and poultry products from Denmark with immediate effect. Heat-treated poultry products, which meet the requirements for heat inactivation of AI virus, will not be affected. This will supersede the earlier restrictions imposed on Middelfart and Aalborg municipalities as stated on our letters dated 29 July 2016 and 11 August 2016 respectively for low pathogenic avian influenza (LPAI).
